


Passport Validity: Your passport must have at least 6 months' validity remaining from your date of entry into USA. Entry to USA is normally refused if you have a passport which is damaged or has pages missing.

If you're a dual national, you must depart USA on the same nationality passport you used to enter If not, you may experience difficulties as you pass through immigration.

TOURIST INFORMATION

The city of West Palm Beach is located in South Florida within Palm Beach County. It's separated from neighboring Palm Beach by the Lake Worth Lagoon. Downtown's Clematis Street and City Place districts are filled with restaurants, shops, bars and clubs. The Norton Meseum of Art displays American, European and Chinese art, including impressionist paintings. 







INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS


Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) DISTANCE: 9 MILES

Please note that all riders must wear a helmet and approved life vest. All participants ride/compete at their own risk.
















FEDERATION ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED

All riders must be members, in good standing, of their respective country's IWWF affiliated National Federation. How it works? Locate the Federation that pertains to your country of residence, and purchase Membership, if you do not have an active Membership in place.

MANDATORY IWWF LICENSE FEE

Annual license fee for all IWWF ranked competitors of \$25 must be paid by each competitor to be eligible to compete. This portion will be included within the entry fee paid directly to Shark Wake Park.

ENTRY FEE

Entry fee of USD \$250 are to be received by Shark Wake Park, no later than September 21st, during official event check in. Entry fees can be paid by credit card.

DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION SEPTEMBER 5TH, 2022

Failure of an athlete to pay entry fee by deadline, September 5, will incur a USD \$10.00 penalty for each additional day. Register through www.cablewakeboard.net

AMMENDUM

PAN AMERICAN REGULATIONS DO NOT ALLOW INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE AGE OF 11 TO COMPETE INTERNATIONALLY.

UNDER 11 DIVISIONS

THE UNDER 11 BOYS/GIRLS DIVISION WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR INTERNATIONAL RANKING POINTS. INSTEAD, THE UNDER 11 BOYS/GIRLS DIVISION(S) WILL RUN ALONGSIDE THE PAN AMERICAN CABLE WAKEBOARD & WAKESKATE CHAMPIONSHIPS AS THE 'USA GROM CABLE WAKEBOARD NATIONALS'. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS DIVISION, INDIVIDUALS REMAIN UNDER 11 YEARS OLD, BY SEPTEMBER 21, 2022.

UNDER 14 DIVISIONS

COMPETITORS MUST HAVE REACHED HIS OR HER 11TH BIRTHDAY BY SEPTEMBER 21, 2022 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE UNDER 14 BOYS/GIRLS DIVISION. COMPETITORS WHO ARE NOT 11 BY SEPTEMBER 21, 2022 MAY ONLY COMPETE IN THE UNDER 11 DIVISION, WHICH IS SEPARATE, AND HELD ALONGSIDE THE PAN AM EVENT, AS THE USA GROM CABLE WAKEBOARD NARTIONALS.
